There are three areas in Port Fairy where craft stalls can trade during the Port Fairy Folk Festival weekend.

In past years, the Port Fairy Folk Festival has managed stalls at Railway Place, however Port Fairy Community House is now coordinating stalls in this area. In 2020, Railway Place will feature vibrant roving performers and buskers.

Stall fees

- Site fees for craft stalls in the Arena are \$1,100 per stall.
- Craft stalls will be provided with a 6 x 6m marquee, 500 watts of power, a stall front and a light. This is included in the above fees.
- In addition to the \$1,100 stall fee, stallholders are required to purchase a Festival ticket for each person/staff member who will be working at the stall for any part of the Festival. These tickets will be priced at the *Subscriber* ticket discount rate (\$255). No tickets are included in the site fees. Half festival tickets (Fri/Sat and Sun/Mon) will also be available at the early bird ticket price of \$175. Please see full terms and conditions for more details.
- Payment for craft site fees and tickets must be made within 5 working days of being offered a stall.
